

Credentials document successful completion of a specific body of content knowledge.

SC Endeavors awards three levels of credentials as a way to promote career development for those who educate and care for children in our state. Individuals may enroll at their local SC technical/community college to take the coursework. Your earned credential certificate can be downloaded within your registry account.


All courses must have been taken since 2001 at one of the 16 technical/community colleges in South Carolina to earn any Early Childhood credential.

To apply for the Credentials and/or Smart Money Bonus in the Registry:

- Login and upload your transcript from one of the SC Technical Colleges to the Education tab of your registry profile. Transcript must align with the acceptable documentation policy listed on our website.
- You do not have to work in child care to receive a credential.
- Employment must be verified in registry account and submit a W-9 to receive bonus.

 Smart Money Bonuses may be available for individuals who earn credentials.

Smart Money Bonuses

If you earned a Credential, and meet the following criteria, you will be eligible for a Smart Money Bonus as long as funds are available:

- 18 years or older, and resident of SC
- Currently work in a state regulated child care program in SC, and
- At least one course for each Level 2 and Level 3 Credential must be taken since January 2012 to qualify for Smart Money Bonuses

LEVEL 1 CREDENTIALS

SC Early Childhood Credential

This credential is awarded for successful completion of the 3-credit hour introductory course, Early Childhood Development 101, (ECD 101), at one of the 16 technical/community colleges in South Carolina. This course serves as the foundation for Level 2 and Level 3 Credentials.

REQUIREMENT

ECD 101 Introduction to Early Childhood

If you have completed ECD 101 (in 2001 or later) with a grade of “C” or higher, you are eligible to receive the SC Early Childhood Credential.

School Age Credential

This credential is awarded for successful completion of the 3-credit hour introductory course in out-of-school time care at one of the 16 technical/community colleges in South Carolina.

REQUIREMENT

SAC 101 Best Practices in School Age and Youth Care Skills

If you have completed SAC 101 with a grade of “C” or higher, you are eligible to receive the School Age Credential.

LEVEL 2 CREDENTIALS

After earning the SC Early Childhood Credential, students may choose a specialization in one of 5 areas to earn a Level 2 Credential by successfully completing, in 2001 or later, with a grade of “C” or higher the three 3-credit hour courses in their chosen area.

Infant Toddler Credential 2

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 102** Child Development I
- ECD 200** Curriculum Issues in Infant/Toddler Care
- ECD 205** Socialization and Group Care of Infants and Toddlers

Preschool Credential 2

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 102** Child Development I
- ECD 105** Guidance and Classroom Management
- ECD 107** Exceptional Children

Director Credential 2

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 105** Guidance and Classroom Management
- ECD 108** Family and Community Relations
- ECD 109** Administration and Supervision

Special Needs Credential 2

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 102** Child Development I
- ECD 107** Exceptional Children
- ECD 210** Early Childhood Intervention or **ECD 132** Creative Expressions

Family Child Care Credential 2

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 102** Child Development I
- ECD 135** Health, Safety, and Nutrition
- ECD 205** Socialization and Group Care of Infants/Toddlers

LEVEL 3 CREDENTIALS

After earning the SC Early Childhood Credential, and Level 2 Credential in one of the 5 specializations, students may choose to continue their specialization by successfully completing in 2001 or later with a grade of “C” or higher the three 3-credit hour courses to earn their Level 3 Credential.

Infant Toddler Credential 3

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 131** Language Arts
- ECD 207** Inclusive Care for Infants/Toddlers
- ECD 251** Supervised Field Experience with Infants/Toddlers or **ECD 243** with documentation of IT placement

Preschool Credential 3

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 131** Language Arts
- ECD 132** Creative Expressions or **ECD 133** Science and Math
- ECD 203** Child Development II

Director Credential 3

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 135** Health, Safety, and Nutrition
- ECD 201** Principles of Ethics and Leadership
- MGT 121** Small Business Management or **MGT 120 /MGT 101**

Special Needs Credential 3

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 203** Child Development II
- ECD 207** Inclusive Care of Infants/Toddlers
- ECD 260** Methods of Teaching Special Needs or **ECD 259** Behavior Management or **ECD 253** American Sign Language

Family Child Care Credential 3

Students must successfully complete the following three 3-credit hour courses at one of the 16 technical/community colleges.

- ECD 108** Family and Community Relations
- ECD 131** Language Arts
- MGT 121** Small Business Management or **MGT 120/MGT 101**
